NON-SECURE DETENTION

Last month we mentioned that the Group



Home is again providing Non-secure Detention Services to youth who in the past would have been placed in detention. We have already served 6 youth in Non-Secure Detention.

In addition, runaway services are being used in lieu of incarceration. Running away is a status offense, which means it is a misbehavior which would not be criminal if committed by an adult (e.g., truancy, runaway, etc.) but is defined as an offense when committed by a minor because of the minor's status.
